Help is available for older adults whose health or independence is at risk.

The North Central Texas Area Agency on Aging (NCTAAA) has funding to

- purchase heaters or air conditioning units
- pay utility bills to prevent shut-off
- pay rent to prevent eviction

Now through August 31, 2019

To qualify, individuals must:

- be at least 60 years of age
- live in Collin, Denton, Ellis, Erath, Hood, Hunt, Johnson, Kaufman, Navarro, Palo Pinto, Parker, Rockwall, Somervell, or Wise county
- meet additional eligibility rules (see reverse side of flyer)

Purchase/payment requirements

For purchase of heaters or air conditioners, the qualifying individual must be able to show that the unit is needed to prevent living in an unsafe housing condition.

For payment of utility bills or rent, the qualifying individual must have a utility shut-off or eviction notice.

Qualifying individuals must also meet four of the following five criteria:

- 1. Low income: \$1,560 for individual or \$2,113 for couple (per month)
- 2. Impairments in two or more activities of daily living: walking, dressing, bathing, eating, grooming, toileting
- 3. Recent (within the last two weeks) inpatient health-related stay: hospital, rehabilitation facility, or skilled nursing facility
- 4. Diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or related dementia
- 5. No caregiver help.
